Who is BREOC?

BREOC, or the Battle River Economic Opportunities Committee is a partnership of seven municipalities taking ownership of driving economic prosperity in their region. It is a partnership of seven municipalities including the County of Paintearth, Flagstaff County, Castor, Coronation, Halkirk, Forestburg, and Heisler.

Sector Overview

The BREOC region has long been the backbone of the agricultural powerhouse that is Alberta. The region's arable lands, abundance of sunshine and extensive irrigation networks make it an ideal place to produce agricultural products and as a result, a desirable area for value-added agricultural businesses and organizations to thrive.


