BREOC, or the Battle River Economic Opportunities Committee is a partnership of seven municipalities taking ownership of driving economic prosperity in their region. It is a partnership of seven municipalities including the County of Paintearth, Flagstaff County, Castor, Coronation, Halkirk, Forestburg, and Heisler.

Sector Overview

The Battle River Region's history is entrenched in the energy sector. From Alberta's oil confluence with the Hardisty Tank Farm to the mining sector, the Region is a global player. However, the region has understood and embraced that while deep roots provide stability, growth requires innovation and diversification. Some examples are the adaptation of the Battle River Transfer station from coal to natural gas; the capture of fly ash at the Paintearth Mine; and the development of Alberta's third largest wind farm outside of Halkirk. These recent projects have retooled the region and shown its willingness to diversify and adapt to the ever-shifting economic landscapes. The future of energy is bright in the Battle River Region.
